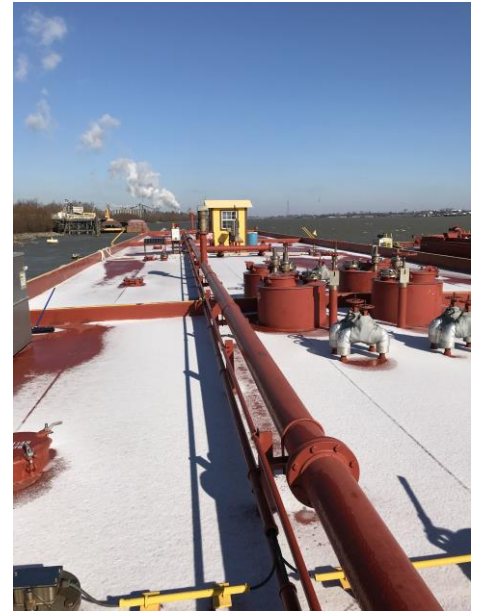
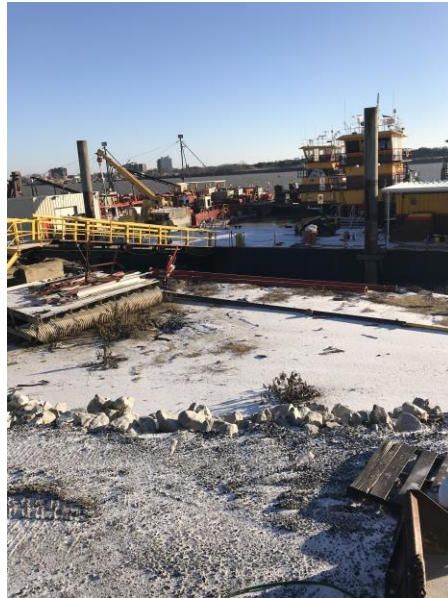
Crew News
